<b>Welcome Back to Worship!</b> If you are interested in joining the ECHS Chapel Worship Team (vocals, musicians, and audio/visual tech), plan to attend our first Worship Team meeting on Thursday, September 8 in the Auditorium from 3:15PM to 4:15PM. <u>Math Club</u> meets on Thursdays of each week during SOAR. It is a yearly commitment where we compete internation- ally monthly from October to March in addition to 3 other yearly competitions. <u>Precalculus and calculus students</u> are required to have a graphing calculator the first day of school. The standard calculator of the school is a TI 84 plus. Precalculus students are also required to purchase a Geometry stencil to be use in the navigation and survey unit. They are about \$3.00 and can be purchased from Mrs. Andrews.

**Sign up for the PSAT:** Juniors and Sophomores are urged to sign up to take the PSAT. The test will be Saturday, October 15 at ECHS. Sign up in the College & Career with Mrs. Shepley. Cost is \$25 and is due when you sign up.

## **General Information:**

<u>School Entrances:</u> All exterior doors to the building are kept locked 24/7. Students are assigned an I.D. Key Card to gain access to the building. Students will be given their cards the first day of school. Students:

- If you arrive to school after 8:10 a.m. you must enter the school building through the front door using your I.D. key card.
- You must carry your I.D. key card with you at all times. Failure to have your I.D. card will result in a lunch detention.
- Do not open outside doors and allow visitors to access the school building. Visitors:

• In order to gain access to the building visitors must identify themselves using the photo screen at the front door. <u>Lunch</u>: Students may eat in the cafeteria, outside in front of school, or other designated areas that will be posted in the cafeteria. The parking lots and athletic field are off-limits at all times during lunch.

**<u>Cell Phones</u>**: Cell phones are not allowed to be on or out during class time. Cell phones that ring or are used during class time will be confiscated and must be picked up in the Deans' Office by a parent.

**Medications:** Medication cannot be dispensed from the Front Office or the Deans' Office. The nurse is in school 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. NO medication will be dispensed after 11:30 a.m. Students who do not feel well after 11:30 a.m. are to go the Deans' Office.

<u>Announcements and Posters</u>: ALL announcements and posters MUST be approved by Mrs. Kuder before they are posted of the walls throughout the school.

If you are a new student to ECHS or an incoming freshman, you need to submit a New Student Physical and a copy of vaccinations to the nurse by September 30. If you have already submitted those forms, thank you. If you have any questions, you can see the nurse. Physical forms can be found at www.easternchristian.org.

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## **General Athletic Information**

**Busing:** All buses for athletic events leave from either behind the school or the side entrance by the cafeteria. **Shuttle Bus** to ECMS for after school practices leaves from the behind the school. It cannot wait, so students are asked to please get on the bus ASAP. If you miss the bus you cannot get to ECMS.
