A Message from Mrs. Sandra Bottge, Principal

Each year at ECES, we plan a school-wide PBL project. PBL stands for Problem Based Learning. In a PBL project, students are presented with a problem through the form of an essential question. Students need to collaborate together to come up with answers or solutions to the problem. Students take ownership of the project while teachers facilitate the learning. At the end of the project, students present their solutions.

Our PBL projects are connected with our spiritual theme and our grade-level curriculum. In this year's PBL project, students will reflect on what it means to be made *In His Image*. We recognize that, although we are all created in God's image, we are all different and unique. It is important for us to care for one another and show empathy to others. Our essential question this year is: Since we are all created in God's image, how can we show empathy to our fellow students at ECES?

Students in 4B helped present this year's PBL project by acting out short skits where characters did not show empathy to each other. Each skit ended with the question, "How would you show empathy in this situation?"

Over the next few months, students will learn about empathy and how we can love and care for all of God's children. Students will present their answers to this year's essential question in chapel on May 9.
