From Laura Gorter, RN, ECMS School Nurse: Tis' the Season! Students are beginning to become absent because of illness, and some are coming to school ill. Just a reminder of part of our student health policy, found in the Student/Parent Handbook: "In keeping with our goal of providing a healthy environment for all students attending Eastern Christian School, the following is adopted to that end: ...Any child who is exhibiting any of the following signs or symptoms of contagious viral or bacterial disease will be excluded from the classroom at the discretion of the principal, school nurse, or the classroom teacher. If any of these symptoms remain chronic, the recommendation of the child's pediatrician will be sought regarding the advisability of readmission into the classroom:

- a. Vomiting,
- b. Fever in excess of 100.0° F
- c. Constant and persistent coughing, sneezing or runny nose

- d. Bleeding, oozing or running sores or abrasions that are not or cannot be covered, or
- e. Red, itching eyes with discharge

Please keep this in mind before sending your child, who may be ill, to school. Also, please keep your child home until 24 hours after a fever has subsided on its own (without fever reducing medications). Thank you for your cooperation! (And feel free to send a box of tissues in at any time!) Laura is in the health office from about 11:30 to 2:00 every day.
