Message From the Principal:

On Thursday evening, we had a brilliant performance by our ensemble groups (band, choruses, and orchestra) which reflected the many hours of practice and the masterful direction of our Music department staff. Attending Christmas concerts is something that we have come to expect as a part of our Christmas season schedules. Of course we go to support our children our those whom we know that are performing, but there is also a bit of joy that comes from immersing yourself in the traditions of the Christmas season. A sentimentality of things remembered - families members and holidays past - come flooding back as you take in these types of Christmas events.

Even more importantly, the events of this season have the effect of preparing us for the celebration of our Savior's birth. They rightly focus our attention not on the way we celebrate Christmas, but the Reason we do. For me, there is something about the language of Christmas carols and the theology contained in them that stirs up the reminders about Who Christ is and what He did by stepping down into Creation.

One of my favorite lines was added to O Come O Come Emmanuel in the early 1900's. The verse includes the title for Jesus as "Desire of nations." Each time I hear the verse, I think of the striving that happens around the world as people and/or nations vie for power and for peace. Ironically, that peace has already been won, and is freely offered to all. Yet it is not in power as the world sees it that this peace is obtained - it comes in the form of a baby. As the angel proclaimed, "I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." That which we desire, has come to us.


TRIP:
