A Message from Mrs. Sandra Bottge, Principal:

Welcome Back! Our first few days of school have been exciting and busy. We met new teachers, made new friends and began learning what it means to be *Living Stones*. Our weekly chapel will be held on Tuesdays from 8:30-9:00. Parents and guests are always welcome to join us for chapel.

Students in grades 2-4 will take **MAP** tests beginning next week. **Measures** of **A**cademic **P**rogress is a standardized test administered to students on the computer. Unlike other standardized tests that offer the same questions to each child in the grade level, MAP tests determine the appropriate level of questioning for each student by presenting more difficult questions each time a student answers a question correctly and easier questions each time a student answers a question incorrectly.

Students will be tested in Math, Reading, and Language Usage in the fall and again in the spring. Testing twice a year allows us to see how students are growing academically during the school year and challenges us answer the following questions: Are our students learning? How do we know? What can we do to increase learning?

Parents can help their children prepare for MAP tests by providing an appropriate amount of sleep, eating a nutritious breakfast and making sure that students arrive for school on time. Parent results will be sent home in early October. Below is the elementary school MAP test schedule:
