<u>PSAT Signup NOW</u> – juniors and sophomores are urged to sign up to take the PSAT. The **test is Wednesday, October 28**, during the morning. The **payment and sign up deadline is next week Friday, Sept 18**. Bring the \$20 fee, sign up in the College and Career Office, and pick up the PSAT booklet, which is now available.

<u>PSAT URGENT NOTICE FOR ALL PARENTS</u> – All high school parents will receive a letter which was sent home yesterday that explains the new PSAT format. The test will be administered on a school day morning and the letter includes instructions for those students who will not be taking the PSAT, as well as the test takers. **ALL PARENTS!** Please be sure to read this letter!
