Thank you for your interest in Eastern Christian School. This checklist is designed to assist you in the application process. <u>International Applications for Enrollment should be submitted for consideration as follows:</u>

• Fall Semester (August): There are two deadlines for Fall Semester Applications:

<u>Early Decision</u>: The deadline for early decision applications is **February 15** of the applying year. An admissions decision will be sent to students by **March 1**. If a student is not accepted for early decision, they will remain in the pool of applicants for the April 1 deadline.

Regular Admission: The deadline for regular admission is **April 1** of the applying year. An admissions decision will be sent to students by April 15.

• **Spring Semester (January):** No later than **November 1** of the applying year. An admissions decision will be sent to students by November 10.

Eastern Christian School requires that International Students complete one full academic year on our campus and are required to pay one full year's tuition. One-half of the tuition will be applied to the Spring Semester and the balance will be applied to the Fall Semester of the following school year.

ALL forms and documentation must be officially translated into English, or they will not be accepted by Eastern Christian School. This will cause a delay in the acceptance consideration.

Step One: Application Phase:

- 1. You and your parents should complete and submit the following forms:

 - Student Agreement and Liability Release
 - Financial Form
 - Tuition Worksheet
- 2. Please have your current school personnel complete the following forms:
 - o English Teacher Recommendation Form
 - School Recommendation Form
 - Official School Transcript (must be translated into English)
- 3. Have your pastor complete the following form:
 - Pastor's Form

- 4. Submit the following forms:
 - Copy of Applicant's Passport
 - Immunization Record
 - A copy of the score of ONE of the following English Proficiency Tests (Grades 9-12 only)
 - ♣ Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) www.ets.org/toefl

 - SSAT (unofficial score will be accepted) www.ssat.org
- 5. Submit the \$250 Non-Refundable Application Fee with your completed application. Eastern Christian School will accept a check, money order or a bank wire transfer.

The application process will not continue until ALL of the above documentation and the \$250 application fee are received by Eastern Christian School.

Step Two: Interview Phase:

Once the International Student Program Director has received all documents, forms and fees, an Eastern Christian School representative will contact you to schedule a student interview.

- If the parent(s) and child are in the United States, the interview will be conducted in person at Eastern Christian School.
- If the parent(s) and child are not in the United States, then an official representative of Eastern Christian School will conduct the interview through an online service, such as Skype, or in person.

The interview will be conducted to assist the school in determining the following:

- The commitment of the family to serving Jesus Christ in all ways, including education.
- The parents' support for school policies and procedures that will hold the student accountable.
- The student's fluency in speaking English. An applicant requesting admission to the upper grades (9-12) must be proficient in English before acceptance will be considered.

Step Three: Acceptance Phase:

After the interview is completed, all records, forms and a summary of the interview will be submitted to the respective Eastern Christian School administrator for review. If the applicant meets all of the Eastern Christian School admissions requirements, the Eastern Christian School International Office will notify the parents that the student has been accepted as an ECS student.

The \$1,500 International Student Acceptance Fee (non-refundable) must be received before a USCIS Form I-20 will be issued or transferred.

Final Step: Enrollment Phase:

Enrollment is not official until all the documentation, fees, etc. are received.

- Signed Tuition Contract
- A copy of the F-1 Student Visa
- Official Physical Examination Form (signed by a licensed physician and translated into English). The physical examination and all immunizations must be current.
- All tuition and fees are in U.S. currency. Tuition and fees are due by wire transfer to Eastern Christian School by August 1 of the applying year (Fall Semester) in order to hold the student's place at Eastern Christian School. For students applying for the Spring Semester, tuition is due by January 1.

International Parent / Guardian Agreement

As an international student attending Eastern Christian School, your child's situation and responsibilities are unique. Not only is he or she pursuing an education, a mastery of the English language, and future possibilities for life, he or she is also adjusting to a new culture. For a successful transition, it is vital that open communication be possible between the school and the host family that your child resides with.

It is also vital that this information be current in order for Eastern Christian to comply with the demands placed on the educational institutions by the INS. It would not be fair to other International students if one student's lack of diligence led to Eastern Christian losing the privilege to grant I-20 status to future international students. Therefore, it is necessary for international students to agree to the following:

- The child will reside with their parents, legal guardian or a host family approved by Eastern Christian School. If the parents, legal guardian or host family parents must be out of town for any reason, it is the parents'/legal guardian's, or host family's responsibility to find proper adult supervision and notify Eastern Christian School of the adult in charge and the duration of the change.
- I will provide the school with current contact information. If the family, legal guardian or host family relocate, then it is my responsibility to notify the International Office of the new address and telephone number.
- I understand that my child will be admitted for a one-semester probationary period and at the end of this probationary period the School Administrator and the International Student Program Director will recommend that he or she continue on probation, be promoted to full standing, or be dismissed from the school.

I understand what is expected of me and agree to cooperate with these expectations. If I have a question or problem with these expectations, I will communicate with the School Administrator or with the International Student Program Director, and if, applicable, the Host Family parents to work for resolution.

I accept my responsibility to work closely with Eastern Christian School in the education of my child and will earnestly seek to support the school as I:

- PRAY for the students, teachers and staff.
- TRUST the staff to act wisely in the education of my child. When there are problems or questions, I pledge to contact the school quickly.
- SPEAK directly with school personnel and refrain from destructive criticism and gossip.
- ENCOURAGE my child to be diligent to meet academic requirements by providing an environment for study, by showing an interest in his/her work, and praise for work faithfully done according to his or her ability.
- FOSTER regular attendance.
- SUPPORT the school staff and the school's guide for Christian conduct.
- PAY my tuition as I have pledged. Notify the school promptly in case of a financial problem.
- CONTRIBUTE to the Eastern Christian School Annual Fund as God enables me.
- UNDERSTAND that my child will be instructed in Reformed Christian doctrine* and view of life.
 - <u>God</u>. There is one infinite, holy, loving, personal God who speaks to us in Scripture and reveals himself to us in his acts of creation, salvation and renewal, as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
 - Creation. The world belongs to God, who created it and faithfully sustains it by His providence.
 - <u>Sin.</u> Our ability to carry out our human calling to honor God, serve our neighbor and care for the creation is ruined by sin, which touches every part of life.
 - Covenant. In response to our sin, God has not rejected or abandoned His world but has turned to it in love.
 - <u>Redemption</u>. God sent Jesus Christ into the world to take the just punishment for sin and its consequences. The atoning death of the Son of God is the only payment for the debt of human sin, and Christ's resurrection is the only liberation from the powers of evil and death.
 - <u>Kingdom of God</u>. Jesus Christ is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and He reigns over all things for the good of His people who live daily in the confident hope of His triumphant return.
 - <u>The Bible</u>. God by His Holy Word reveals Himself; renews man's understanding of God, of man himself, of his fellow man and of the world; directs man in all his relationships and activities; and therefore, guides His people also in the education of their children.
 - School Community. The Christian school, as an enterprise of the entire community, enables and equips all of its students for a life of obedience to their calling in this world as image-bearers of God. The primary responsibility for education rests upon parents to whom children are entrusted by God. Christian parents should accept this obligation in view of the covenantal relationship which God established with believers and their children. The Christian school curriculum is developed and organized so that children may come to know God more deeply and richly, and live for Him more faithfully. Since human experience in all its rich variety is a good gift from the Creator who remains involved in His world, the Christian school curriculum explores all dimensions of creation. God's design for the creation and His will for human society and culture must be understood and obeyed. This is the way of Godly wisdom. Students are taught to recognize the brokenness that sin brings to God's carefully designed world and are challenged to bring the healing power of Jesus Christ to a fallen world**.

Eastern Christian School Association Internet Acceptable Use Policy

Eastern Christian School Association (ECSA) has actively pursued making advanced technology and increased access to learning opportunities available to our students and staff. We are happy to announce that we now can offer Internet services to students and staff for educational purposes. The Board believes this computer technology will help propel our schools into the information age by allowing students and staff to access and use information sources from distant computers, communicate and share information with individuals or groups of other students and staff, and significantly expand their knowledge base. The Internet is a tool for life-long learning and only begins to open the door to many advanced tools.

CONDITIONS AND RULES FOR USE:

1. ACCEPTABLE USE

- a. The purpose of Internet is to facilitate communications in support of research and education, by providing access to unique resources and an opportunity for collaborative work. To remain eligible as a user, the use of your account must be in support of and consistent with the educational objectives of Eastern Christian School. Access to Internet is made possible through an appropriate provider to be designated by ECSA at its sole discretion. All users of the Internet must comply with existing rules, and the terms of conditions for use of the Internet which are incorporated into this document and are available at the Association Office.
- b. Transmission of any material in violation of any United States or state regulation is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, copyrighting material, threatening or obscene material, or material protected by trade secret.
- c. Use of the Internet for commercial activities is not acceptable. Use for product advertisement or political lobbying is also prohibited.

2. PRIVILEGE

The use of Internet is a privilege, not a right. Inappropriate use, including any violation of these conditions and rules may result in cancellation of the privilege. The ECSA Board of Directors, under this agreement, is delegated the authority to determine appropriate use and may deny, revoke, suspend or close any user account at any time based upon its determination of inappropriate use by account holder or user. Also, The Board may discipline or seek legal prosecution for any student who violates the agreement and/or the terms and conditions for use of the Internet.

3. MONITORING

The Board of Directors reserves the right to review any material and to monitor fileserver space in order to make determinations on whether specific uses of the network are inappropriate.

4 NETWORK ETIQUETTE

All users are expected to abide by the generally accepted rules of network etiquette. These include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a. Be polite. Do not get abusive in your messages to others.
- b. Use appropriate language. Do not swear, use vulgarities or any other inappropriate language. Do not engage in activities that are prohibited under state or federal law.
- c. Do not reveal your personal address or phone numbers.
- d. Note that electronic mail (e-mail) is not guaranteed to be private. People who operate the system do have access to all mail. Messages relating to or in support of illegal activities may be reported to the authorities and may result in the loss of user privileges.
- e. Do not use the network in such a way that you would disrupt the use of the network.
- f. All communications and information accessible via the network should be assumed to be private property and therefore subject to all copyright regulations.

5. NO WARRANTIES

ECSA makes no warranties of any kind, whether expressed or implied, for the service it is providing. The Board and its representatives will not be responsible for any damages a user suffers. This includes loss of data resulting from delays, non-deliveries, mis-deliveries, or service interruptions caused by ECSA's negligence or by the user's errors or omissions. Use of any information obtained via the Internet is at the user's own risk. ECSA's Board of Directors specifically denies any responsibility for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through its services. All users need to consider the source of any information they obtain, and consider how valid that information may be.

6. SECURITY

- a. Security on any computer system is a high priority, especially when the system involves many users. Users must never allow others to use their password. Users should also protect their password to ensure system security and their own privilege and ability to continue to use the system.
- b. If you feel you can identify a security problem on Internet, you must notify a system administrator. Do not demonstrate the problem to other users.
- c. Do not use another individual's account.
- d. Attempts to long on to the Internet as a system administrator may result in cancellation of user privileges.
- e. Any user identified as a security risk for having a history of problems with other computer systems may be denied access to Internet.

7. VANDALISM AND HARASSMENT

- a. Vandalism and harassment will result in cancellation of user privileges and other disciplinary action.
- b. Vandalism is defined as any malicious attempt to harm, modify, and destroy data of another user to Internet, or other networks that are connected to the Internet backbone. This includes, but is not limited to, the uploading or creating of computer viruses.
- c. Harassment is defined as the persistent annoyance of another user, or the interference of another user's work. Harassment includes, but is not limited to, the sending of unwanted mail.

8. PROCEDURES FOR USE

- a. Student users must always get permission from their instructors and/or Media Specialist before using the network or accessing any specific file or application. The user must follow all written and oral instructions.
- b. Student users must sign-in legibly on the appropriate log or register in the classroom each time they use the network.
- c. All users have the same right to use the equipment. Therefore, users shall not play games or use the computer resources for other non-academic activities. In addition, users shall not waste nor take supplies, such as paper, printer ribbons and diskettes.

9. ENCOUNTER OR CONTROVERSIAL MATERIAL

However, on a global network it is impossible to effectively control the content of data, and an industrious user may discover controversial material. It is the user's responsibility not to initiate access to such material.
