A Message from Mrs. Sandra Bottge, Principal:

We began preparing our hearts for Christmas in chapel this week. Most of our student said their homes are already decorated for Christmas. We learned that many Christmas decorations have special meanings that teach us about Jesus.

Christmas Lights: Our world is full of sin. Sin is symbolized by darkness. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world" (John 8:12). We know that Jesus came to the earth to remove the darkness and light the way for us to go to heaven.

Stars and Angels: When we look up to the top of our Christmas tree, we can imagine what it was like for the wise men and shepherds to look up into the night sky at the bright star or the multitude of angels that proclaimed the good news and led them to Jesus.

Wreath: Christmas wreaths symbolize our eternal life in heaven. The round shape has no beginning and no ending. Their evergreen leaves stay green and full of life forever.

Advent Wreath: The candles on the advent wreath teach us about hope, preparation, joy and love. Our hope in Jesus is a confident hope. We know we have eternal life in Jesus. We need to prepare our hearts to meet Jesus by confessing our sin, asking for forgiveness and asking Jesus to live in our heart. When we have Jesus in our heart, our life will be overflowing with life-changing joy that is not dependent on our circumstances. We know this is true because God loved the world so much that He allowed His son to die for our sin.

Students were challenged to talk with their families about the special meaning behind their Christmas decorations and to tell others about the Good News of Jesus' birth.
