<u>A Message from Mrs. Sandra Bottge, Principal:</u>

Yesterday's snowfall was a great reminder of the beauty of God's creation. His Word tells us that although our "...sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow" (Isaiah 1:18).

Our students love to play in the snow. Some of our teachers do too! In the winter months, it is important for students to be prepared for snow by wearing snow pants, boots and coats. Students who are not prepared to play in the snow will play on the blacktop. We allow 1st-4th grade students to go sledding on the hill behind the school using our plastic, roll-up sleds. Students do not need to bring their own sleds.

We know how important outside playtime is for our students even in cold weather. Students will play outside for recess throughout the entire year as long as the temperature and wind-chill is 20°. Please make sure your children are appropriately dressed for outside play every day. On days where children need boots, they should have another pair of shoes to wear inside.
