The culture of encouragement at EC is an overflow of our Christian commitments. It shines through in how our students feel supported in their day-to-day lives and, over time, influences their long-term trajectory in life.

We believe our supportive culture leads to more confidence — and that self-assurance can lead to your teen registering for a challenging class, trying a new sport, going on a missions trip, or discovering a new skill.

An Education that Prepares Your Teen to Excel

Regardless of your teen's academic giftings, Eastern Christian School pushes students to do their personal best. Our academic and college counselors work with students on a variety of strategic and practical matters — from determining which classes to take to align with their college goals to making the most of EC's block schedule. Your young scholar will get the help they need to excel.

- If your teen hopes to get a jump start on college credits, we offer **Project Acceleration**, which is a dual enrollment program with Seton Hall University. While in high school, students have access to courses bearing 30+ college credits, which can shorten an undergraduate degree to three years or a master's to four years.
- The Education Support Services helps students with a wide range of abilities. Through TESS, students sharpen study skills, practice self-advocacy, and grow in specific academic subject areas.
- If it's hands-on learning that helps your teen thrive, we provide an internship program called **WINGS** in which students can learn trades or experience careers firsthand while receiving high school credit toward graduation. Past internships have included career exploration in law, veterinary science, healthcare and marketing.
- And, if your teen is ready for an extra academic challenge, our newly launched **Honors Academy** is specifically designed to mentor eligible students toward college success and encourage students to pursue academic competitions, service learning, and leadership experience. (It is expected to launch in the fall of 2024.)

A Supportive Christian Environment

CHAPEL

Chapel is an opportunity for leadership and learning at Eastern Christian School. Each week, your teen will gather with their peers and faculty to attend a worship service organized by a class called Bible & Worship. Chapels are often led by student groups, including student worship bands, a dance ministry, and an American Sign Language choir. Parents and family friends are welcome to join us anytime for a time of praise and a message from guest pastors, youth pastors, or EC faculty.

FAITH IN ACTION

FIA is an opportunity for your teen to gain firsthand experience acting as the hands and feet of Jesus.

Between freshman and senior year, students complete a minimum of 50 Faith in Action service hours as a graduation requirement.

For our high school students, service learning includes fundraising, local work, and opportunities to serve abroad to address issues of global poverty, education, and human rights.

MISSIONS

If your teen is interested in making meaningful change happen in the world, trips and service opportunities are provided through our Cross-Cultural Perspectives and Service class. Students first learn about culture, poverty, and other important subjects before going on an impactful Spring Break mission trip.

WE OFFER FOUR WAYS FOR YOUR FAMILY TO TOUR OUR CAMPUS:

- 1 PERSONAL AND GROUP TOURS allow you and your teen to meet with a member of our enrollment team for a tour of our beautiful campus.
- A STUDENT SHADOW EXPERIENCE provides a way for prospective students to experience a day in the life of an Eastern Christian School Eagle. Our student hosts are trained in hospitality and offer a great introduction to our school's culture and atmosphere. (Shadow Days are generally available from Sept. 25 to June 1.)
- **3 OPEN HOUSES** feature a tour of the campus; an explanation of the academic programs and student opportunities; and time to meet student-leaders, administrators, the enrollment team, and lead teachers.
- 4 HIGH SCHOOL PREVIEW DAY is open to eighth graders. Visitors are escorted by high school students through a tour of the campus that introduces them to the facilities, classes, programs, teachers, and more. Visitors enjoy a large extracurricular fair and join in our weekly worship.
